Advance Tutorial Check-In:

Advance check-in for the tutorials will be held from 7:00-8:30 pm (19:00-20:30) on Sunday, September 14th. Go up the escalators to the second floor. We highly recommend that you come at this time if we haven't yet received all of your registration and/or payment information. **This is the best time to check-in if you don't want to wait in long lines!** (See *Speed Check-In* section to find out how to avoid lines altogether!)



Standard Tutorial Check-In:

Standard check-in for the courses will be held **Monday, September 15:**

- 7:30am-8:15am (07:30-08:15)
- 8:00am-1:30pm (08:30-13:30) for later classes

Tuesday, September 16

- 8:00am-1:30pm (07:30-13:30)



Speed Check-In:

Regardless of when you choose to check-in, a *Speed Check-In Ticket* enables you to bypass the lengthy check-in and registration lines and go directly to pick up your course materials. To receive a pink *Speed Check-In Ticket*, we must receive, by September 4th:

- your tutorial registration information **and**
- your payment in full (by Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Diners Club card, bank check, or direct wire transfer), **or** an authorized copy of your purchase order or training form.

The ticket will be emailed or faxed with your registration confirmation letter as soon as we receive your payment information.

When you receive your *Speed Check-In Ticket*, be sure to put it in your wallet for safekeeping. A ticket left behind at your office can't help you speed through the ION GNSS 2008 Tutorials' *Speed Check-In* line!



Class Schedule:

Courses run from

- 8:30am-noon (08:30-12:00)
- 1:30-5:00pm (13:30-17:00) and
- 7:00-9:15pm (19:00-21:15).

Please refer to your confirmation letter for the starting times of your specific tutorials.



Walk-Ins:

Your friends and colleagues who have not pre-registered are also welcome to attend the tutorials on a walk-in basis, depending on space availability. However, they may not receive their course materials in time for class. Even if they are not sure they'll be able to attend, making a tentative registration will help us make plans for materials production and room assignments.

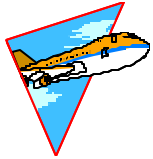
Registration Cancellation Policy:

Registrations may be cancelled by 5:00pm (17:00) Eastern Daylight Time, September 11th without penalty, and attendee substitutions may be made at any time.



Climate and Classroom Attire:

In September, the average temperature in Savannah is 86° F, 30°C with about 249 average days of bright sunshine and blue sky during the warm season although it might rain. There is no dress requirement for class — anything from a polo shirt and jeans, to a military uniform, to a suit and tie, is acceptable. Wear whatever makes you the most comfortable, but remember that meeting room temperatures often vary (and large spaces can be difficult to control), so please dress in layers. *Most often, meeting rooms tend to be cold, so please come prepared!*



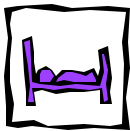
Airport and Transportation:

The Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport offers the most convenient access in and out of Savannah (airport code "SAV"). It is located about 8 miles (25 minute drive) away from the hotel. Taxi service is available outside the airport terminal. Taxi fares to the hotels in the Savannah Historic District are approximately \$15 one-way + \$3 for additional passengers. Greyline Transportation Shuttle is \$17 per person one-way.



Car Rentals/Parking:

Valet Parking: \$17.00 per night.
No self parking available.
Full in/out privileges.
Savannah is easily walkable by foot. You will not need a car to see majority of the historic sites or to grab a bite to eat. There are plenty of bars and restaurants within 5-10 minute walk from hotel.



Lodging:

There are special sleeping room blocks being held at the hotels in the downtown Fort Worth and other outlying hotels. To make reservations

at the special group rates, reserve soon at www.ion.org. Look under "ION GNSS 2008".
(Please reserve *now* — it may be difficult to get a room once these blocks are full.) If you can't attend, please cancel your room 72 hours before arrival to avoid penalties.
